Job Summary:

SES is looking to recruit a fabrication assistant to work in the fabrication workshop of our manufacturing base in Datchet. The successful candidate will be responsible for manufacturing plastic boxes to customer specifications in order for them to be wired and tested by the workshop.

This role is quite physically demanding, as the plastic sheets are large and heavy, and some of the HDPE boxes after being welded can be difficult to manage.

The successful candidate would need to have a willingness to learn new skills and confident enough to speak up and ask if they do not understand how to do something.

In-house training will be provided in order to ensure that the successful candidate is able to complete their task safely and efficiently.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Loading 2M x 1M HDPE (plastic) onto the cutting bed of the AYXZ machines
2. Using power tools to prep HDPE for manufacturing
3. Constructing the HDPE boxes following exact instructions
4. Ensuring the each product meets the high standard SES expects
5. To listen to and follow instructions accurately
6. To follow all Health and Safety guidelines
7. Be responsible for own time keeping, to ensure that contracted hours are completed, regardless of the completion of any overtime.
